In addition, eligible 1/9 Gold Star family members and Association members who have passed away since Vietnam may apply. (Proof of relationship must be provided.) Active-duty members who were part of 1<sup>st</sup> Battalion, 9<sup>th</sup> Marines are encouraged to also apply.

Applicants must be a graduating high school senior, a current college or tech school student, or a post-graduate student. Students must be enrolled in or planning to enroll in accredited courses.

Applicants will be selected based on academic achievement, outstanding character and citizenship, school and community service, and/or financial need.
